Dear School District Administrators,

Based on the Illinois Child Labor Law (820 ILCS 205), the Buffalo Grove Recreation Association, Inc. (BGRA), is required to file with each associated local school district, a letter of intention.

Background

The Buffalo Grove Recreation Association, Inc., also known as the BGRA, is a non-profit corporation chartered by the State of Illinois on February 20, 1961 to foster and promote recreational activities for persons of all ages residing in Buffalo Grove and adjacent areas designated by the elected officials. This is a volunteer program conducted by your neighbors and friends, as part of the total recreational program of the community. This is not a park district, though school and park district facilities are used.

Umpires provide a service that is vital to the successful conduct of the game. Youth umpires are trained and assigned to Farm (age 7-8) through Thoroughbred (11-12) Leagues, according to their age and experience. Adult umpires and umpires over 16 years old are scheduled at the higher age groups. Youth Umpire clinics are scheduled prior to the start of the season regarding rule updates and methods of umpiring.

Umpire Work Schedule and Requirements

- Parent/guardian must be present at the game (12-13 Yr. Olds ONLY)
- Employer must obtain and keep on file a certificate of employment for the minor
- A minor may work a maximum of 3 hours per day on school days OR
- A minor may work a maximum of 4 hours per day on non-school days
- A minor may not exceed 10 hours of work per week
- A minor may not work past 9:00 p.m.
- The participants of the youth sport activity must be at least 3 years younger than the officiating minor.

The working season for the BGRA starts on Saturday April 21, 2012 and will end approximately Saturday August 4, 2012. The hours of any weekday game are from 5:30 p.m. until approximately 7:30 p.m. Weekend games are from 8:30 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. on Saturday and 12:00 p.m. until 7:30 p.m. on Sundays.
